

NATIONAL COACH ACCREDITATION UPDATING REQUIREMENTS



Netball Australia's Coach Accreditation Framework supports the development of coaches from beginner or club level through to international level. Coaches are able to progress along the sixtier accreditation pathway depending on their personal aspirations and ability.

Accredited coaches are required to complete a series of development activities in conjunction with their practical coaching over a four-year period following their successful attainment of their coach accreditation to remain current. Netball Australia recommends that all coaches who become accredited continue to upgrade their knowledge, skills and competencies.

The updating program aims to raise the overall quality of coaches within netball by ensuring they are provided with ongoing education and development opportunities covering areas such as:

- · Keeping abreast of the latest information on developments within netball
- · Having access to the most up-to-date techniques and skills related to coaching
- Rules knowledge and current interpretations

Netball Australia requires a coach to reach the specified number of points of updating activity to remain accredited at the relevant level as indicated in the table below:

Advanced	Complete the Elite Coaching Course within four years OR
	Achieve 80 hours of updating activity over a four-year period.
	Complete another Elite Coaching Course within four years OR
Elite	Complete the High Performance Coaching Course within four years OR
	Achieve 100 hours of updating activity over a four-year period.
High Performance	Achieve 120 hours of updating activity over a four-year period.





Updating Activities

- 50% of the required updating for each level should be completed through practical coaching.
- Practical coaching can be undertaken with any level of athlete or team or official and may occur on a regular basis (weekly, fortnightly) or in specific situations such as camps, clinics.
- The successful completion of the Rules of Netball Theory Exam (70% pass mark) is a mandatory updating requirement for all coach accreditation levels.
- The remaining updating must come from professional development activities as per the update criteria specified for each accreditation level as indicated in the tables below.
