## 1. Background

- 1.1 Netball Australia Limited (“**NA**”) (ABN 66 003 142 818) is an Australian public company limited by guarantee and is the national governing body for netball in Australia. NA and each ANO (defined in clause 2 below) provides access to a number of Online Systems (defined in clause 3 below) for the benefit of netball participants, netball fans, other netball stakeholders and the general public. These Online Systems are generally operated by the relevant ANO on servers in Australia but may also be operated by third parties contracted by ANOs or our suppliers from time to time, using servers both in and out of Australia.
- 1.2 For the purposes of these Conditions of Use (“**Conditions of Use**”), each of the following is an **Australian Netball Organisation** or **ANO**, and these Conditions of Use apply to each of these Australian Netball Organisations to the extent that they are required to have Conditions of Use in place by law or have not adopted separate Conditions of Use:
- a. NA;
  - b. each of NA’s related bodies corporate (as that term is defined in the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth)), including Netball Events Pty Ltd ABN 58 101 439 981; and
  - c. The Confident Girls Foundation Limited (ABN 62 614 643 882).
- 1.3 For the purposes of these Conditions of Use, the term “Online Systems” includes:
- a. Websites and apps, including netball.com.au, the Netball Live app, [nwc2027.com](http://nwc2027.com), and confidentgirlsfoundation.com.au;
  - b. A computer or device connected to a network (such as the internet);
  - c. Any software, database, file, interface or webpage available for access, use, downloading, exporting or reading;
  - d. Systems, platforms or portals (howsoever described or branded) that deal with matters such as ticket reservations, participant registration and management, competition, tournament or league management, high performance, online learning/education, online help, online chat or messaging available directly through a computer system or under its direct control, including World Sport Action, PlayHQ or Netball Connect;
  - e. Digitised content that can be transmitted over the internet or computer networks (which can include text, audio, video, images and graphics); and
  - f. Websites and applications that enable users to create and share content or to participate in social networking.
- that are operated, controlled or otherwise made available by an ANO to you.
- 1.4 These Conditions of Use govern your access to and use of the Online Systems and any information, data, or services provided through or in connection with the Online Systems that are operated, controlled or otherwise made available by an ANO to you (“**Services**”). By ticking the “I agree to the Conditions of Use” (or similar) box/radio button, or registering your details on, or logging into, accessing or using the Online Systems or Services, you are deemed to agree to these Conditions of Use and your access to and use of the Online Systems and Services is conditional upon your compliance with these Conditions of Use. If you do not agree to these Conditions of Use, you must immediately exit or logout and cease to access or use the Online Systems and Services. Some Online Systems are owned by

third-parties and licensed to an ANO and the third-party licensor might have their own terms of use that you are also required to agree to.

- 1.5 You may be required to accept or agree to other agreements, terms, conditions, rules or policies or the payment of fees or charges to access, download, login, register, transact on, or use on an Online System or Service, including in relation to tickets, merchandise, venues, programs, events, education, competitions, memberships, participation, app downloads, in-app purchases. If you download an Online System from a third-party app store (for example, Apple's App Store or Google Play), you must also comply with that store's terms and conditions.
- 1.6 You may access or use the Online Systems or Services as much or as little as you like, subject to your compliance with these Conditions of Use and any limitations, fair use policies or restrictions imposed by an ANO from time to time. If you pay for the access or use of an Online System or Service, including a periodic subscription, but do not use it to its full capacity or available allocation then you are not entitled to refund for any unused or underutilised component.

## 2. Conduct

- 2.1 NA wants everyone who uses the Online Systems or Services, including netball participants, to have a safe and enjoyable experience and NA needs your help to ensure this is the case. As such, in using the Online Systems and Services you agree that you will comply with NA's Integrity Policies ([Integrity Policies - netball.com.au](https://www.netball.com.au/integrity-policies)) and will not:
  - a. Post content to an Online System that is:
    - i. Hateful or racially offensive;
    - ii. Threatening or abusive;
    - iii. Obscene, offensive, defamatory, discriminatory, racist, ageist, sexist, vulgar, indecent, pornographic, profane or contains nudity or graphic or gratuitous violence;
    - iv. Likely or intend to incite violence; or
    - v. Unlawful or encourages conduct that would contravene any law.
  - b. Use an Online System for any improper or unlawful purpose, including:
    - i. Stalking, harassing, bullying or discriminating against anyone;
    - ii. Misleading or deceptive conduct, defamation, libel, slander, fraud, identity theft, passing off, contempt or a breach of confidence, privacy or any third party's rights, including intellectual property rights; or
    - iii. Criminal acts, including conspiring to commit, aiding or abetting any criminal acts.
  - c. Impersonate any other person or entity while using an Online System or Service;
  - d. Upload, introduce or store viruses, worms, trojan horses, malware, or other malicious or harmful computer activity, code, files or programs designed to deny, interrupt, harm, damage, destroy or limit technical or functional performance,

- integrity, privacy or security of an Online System or Service or engage in a denial-of-service attack on the Online System or Service (collectively “Attacks”);
- e. Hack into or do anything that could disable, interfere with, overburden, or impair the proper working or appearance or performance or integrity or security of an Online System or Service;
  - f. Copy, reverse-engineer, decompile, decipher, disassemble or modify any Online System or Service;
  - g. Collect content from any Online System or Service using automated means (such as harvesting bots, robots, spiders, or scrapers); or
  - h. Post commercial communications (including ‘spam’ or advertisements) on an Online System without an ANO’s express authority; or
  - i. Use an Online System or Service for the purpose of any form of marketing without our authority, including ambush marketing.
- 2.2 The ANOs do not systematically review content that is posted on the Online Systems and is not responsible for that content, but an ANO may screen, edit delete or remove any content from any Online System at any time (in its sole and absolute discretion).
- 2.3 Each ANO reserves the right to cooperate fully with any law enforcement authority in any jurisdiction in respect of any lawful direction or request to disclose the identity or other information in respect of anyone (including you) posting material which violates or allegedly violates any law.
- 2.4 If you believe that the behaviour or material of another user is objectionable or contrary to these Conditions of Use, you can report the behaviour or material to NA using the contact details below. Despite this, we are not obliged to take any action and will not arbitrate any dispute or claims between you and others.
- 2.5 You must access and use the Online Systems and Services in accordance with any instructions, manuals, FAQs, help files or other documentation that is made available by an ANO in connection with the Online System or Service – including materials located online.

### 3. Participants

- 3.1 Without limiting anything else in these Conditions of Use, if you are a netball participant then:
- a. you must comply with the rules of netball and the various regulations, terms, conditions, codes of conduct, policies and procedures (howsoever described) related to your participation in the game. This includes anything promulgated by your respective club, league, regional, state or territory association, an ANO or INF;
  - b. you must comply with NA’s integrity policies (<https://netball.com.au/integrity-policies>) and general policies (<https://netball.com.au/general-policies>); and
  - c. you must promptly pay such fees or charges related to your participation.

## 4. Intellectual Property

- 4.1 All intellectual property rights (including patent, copyright, database and trademark rights) subsisting in, relating to or arising out of the Online Systems or the Services is owned by or licensed to the relevant ANO, unless otherwise indicated. You acknowledge and agree that neither these Conditions of Use nor your use of or access to the Online Systems or the Services transfers to you any right, title or interest in the intellectual property rights owned by any ANO or licensor.
- 4.2 You must not copy, adapt, modify, reproduce, decompile, communicate, broadcast, make available, transmit, perform, store, republish, print, commercialise, frame, upload or otherwise distribute any material from the Online Systems or Services without NA's consent. In particular, you must not incorporate any material from any part of an Online System or Services in any commercial work or publication, and no material from an Online System or Service may be distributed or copied for any commercial purpose. You may save, print, or reproduce copy from the Online Systems solely for your personal (non-commercial) education or information.
- 4.3 The Online Systems contain copyright, trade names, domain names, social media handles, and registered or unregistered trade marks. These include the names, logos and content of ANOs and their respective channels, products, programs, teams, clubs, licensors, events, leagues, competitions and other activities. You are not permitted to copy or use these copyright or trademarks except with the express written permission of the relevant ANO.
- 4.4 Some parts of the Online Systems may allow you to submit, upload, post, store or transmit content or materials (including text, photographs, graphics, video, audio, statistics or other materials ("Content")). By submitting, uploading, posting or transmitting Content, you:
- a. warrant to each ANO that the Content is your own original work and/or that you have the right to provide the Content to the relevant ANO, it is not defamatory, it does not infringe any intellectual property, copyright, trade mark, patent, design, privacy, confidentiality or any other right of any party or any law, and is provided in accordance with any applicable policies and permissions, including policies related to integrity, child safety and member protection and those located here: <https://netball.com.au/integrity-policies>;
  - b. grant each ANO an irrevocable, perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive, transferable, sub-licensable, worldwide right and licence to (and to authorise others to) use, reproduce, copy, adapt, modify, distribute, publish, perform, communicate, transmit, broadcast, make available, print or display, and to exercise all copyright and publicity rights with respect to the Content worldwide. If you do not want to grant to NA the rights set out above, you should not submit, upload, post or transmit the Content to any Online System;
  - c. consent to each ANO using and publishing (and authorising others to use and publish) your name, character, likeness, image, voice or anything else that identifies you which is contained in the Content;
  - d. genuinely consent to (and to procure from any other person who created any part of the Content their genuine consent to) each ANO doing any act or omission that would otherwise infringe your / their moral rights (as that term is defined in the *Copyright Act 1968* (Cth)) in the Content and present and future rights of a similar nature conferred by statute anywhere in the world, including with respect to the following: (i) alteration of size, colour and shape; (ii) editing and adaptation, including use with other materials and the overlay or superimposition of other materials; (iii) digitisation, including communication to the public; and (iv) non-attribution of the author or

performer, and you also agree, if requested by an ANO, to execute any instrument or document which the ANO believes is required to give effect to any licence, waiver or consent; and

- e. consent to each ANO linking the Content to other material (including material submitted, uploaded, posted, stored or transmitted by other users of the Online Systems or Services and material created by any ANO and/or other third parties),
  - f. consent to each ANO using the Content for the ANO's business purposes, including to promote, market or advertise the ANO and the Online Systems and Services, and to the ANO directly or indirectly gaining commercial benefit from the Content.
- 4.5 You must not link to any ANO website without first obtaining the express written permission of the relevant ANO.
- 4.6 This section D entitled Intellectual Property survives the termination or expiry of these Conditions of Use or your discontinued use of the Online Systems or Services.

## 5. Personal Information

- 5.1 NA respects your privacy. The personal information you submit while using an Online System will be collected, used and disclosed by an ANO in accordance with the [Australian Netball Privacy Policy](#) or [Collection Notice/s](#), which also contains information about how you may access and seek correction of your personal information, how you can complain about a breach of your privacy, and how the complaint will be dealt with, among other things. To the extent that you provide your or a third party's personal information to an ANO via an Online System or Service (including when you register your details, open an account, make a transaction, upload Content, etc) you acknowledge having read, understood and agreeing to the Australian Netball privacy policy and collection notice/s and consent to the relevant ANO's collection, use and disclosure of personal information as per the Australian Netball privacy policy and collection notice/s.
- 5.2 Subject to these Conditions of Use, any person may access or use some of the Online Systems or Services without being required to register with or provide personal information to an ANO, however, you may be required to have an account, register, sign-on as a user or provide personal information to access or make full use of the functionality of certain areas of the Online Systems and Services.
- 5.3 It is your responsibility to keep your personal details, including contact information, accurate and up-to-date so an ANO can most effectively communicate with you and operate the Online Systems and deliver the Services for your benefit.

## 6. Sign-On Credentials

- 6.1 If you have an account or are a registered user of an Online System, you must ensure that you keep your sign-on credentials secret and do not disclose them to anyone – as you are responsible for all activities undertaken under your sign-on credentials.
- 6.2 It is your responsibility to secure your sign-on credentials and immediately notify the relevant ANO of any unauthorised use of your sign-on credentials as soon as you become aware of it. You should regularly monitor the activity under your account or registration.
- 6.3 You must not transfer your sign-on credentials to anyone or be used by anyone without first obtaining NA's written permission.

- 6.4 To the extent that the functionality of an Online System does not already require you to do so, you should change your password regularly.
- 6.5 NA may merge your records if you have duplicate or superfluous sign-on credentials or other records on the Online Systems.
- 6.6 If you are under 18 years old, you should obtain the consent of your parent or guardian before using or registering for an Online System. NA may collect, use and disclose personal information from children and young people in accordance with the Australian Netball Privacy Policy.

## **7. Anti-Spam Notice**

- 7.1 You must not use any personal information (including to names, locations and any email addresses) that appears on an Online System to infer consent to the receipt of unsolicited commercial electronic messages or other communications from you or other third parties. Without limiting the foregoing, the personal information (including, email addresses) of any ANO personnel must not be used by you to send unsolicited commercial electronic messages.
- 7.2 This section G entitled Anti-Spam Notice survives the termination or expiry of these Conditions of Use or your discontinued use of the Online Systems or Services.

## **8. Administrators**

- 8.1 Some functionality of the Online Systems are only available to ANO personnel, or particular groups of ANO stakeholders. Certain third parties are also granted the ability to administer elements of the Online Systems. If you are an administrator of an Online System, your role is to:
  - a. ensure that the information you record in an Online System is accurate and complete;
  - b. update information in Online Systems as and when you become aware that the information is out-of-date;
  - c. maintain the security of your administrator sign-on credentials;
  - d. comply with all aspects of these Conditions of Use; and
  - e. if you are recording personal information in an Online System, ensure:
    - i. the relevant individual is notified that his/her personal information will be used in accordance with the Australian Netball Privacy Policy and Collection Notice/s; and
    - ii. only upload, store or use personal information in the Online System for the purpose it was provided, including the netball activities and purposes described in the Australian Netball Privacy Policy or Collection Notice/s, and not for any other purpose.

## **9. Third Party Websites**

- 9.1 The Online Systems and Services contain links to other websites or systems including social media channels operated by third parties and open source content, services, software or

websites. NA provides these links as a courtesy and ready reference and this should not be interpreted in any way as an endorsement of any website or system, its operator or any goods or services promoted. These third party websites or systems are not under NA's control, and NA is not responsible for, and will not be liable in respect of, the content or operation of those third party websites or systems.

- 9.2 Your correspondence or business dealings with, or participation in promotions of, advertisers, sponsors or third parties found on or through Online Systems or Services, including payment and delivery of related goods or services, and any other terms, conditions, warranties, or representations associated with such dealings, are solely between you and such advertiser, sponsor or third party. You agree that any ANO will not be responsible or liable for any loss or damage of any sort incurred as the result of any such dealings or as the result of the presence of such advertisers, sponsors or third parties on the Online Systems or Services.

## 10. Disclaimer, Limitation of Liability and Indemnity

- 10.1 The information and material contained on or available through the Online Systems and Services is provided to you for general information purposes only. The ANOs do not exclude any rights and remedies in respect of goods or services under the Australian Consumer Law which cannot be excluded, restricted or modified, however, to the fullest extent permitted by law:
- a. The Online Systems and Services are provided on an as-is and as-available basis;
  - b. You use the Online Systems and Services at your own risk;
  - c. You must not place reliance on the information and material contained on or available through the Online Systems and Services as a substitute for appropriate professional coaching, wellbeing and other advice tailored to your specific circumstances. In particular any health, diet or exercise advice is not intended as medical diagnosis or treatment. You should always seek professional medical advice before commencing any new exercise or training program or taking up a new sport such as netball;
  - d. The ANOs provide you with access to the Online Systems and Services without any express or implied warranties, including implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose and non-infringement;
  - e. The ANO's do not guarantee, or make any representations or warranties that the Online Systems and Services will be always safe, secure, current, complete, accurate, available, and free of errors, defects, bugs or viruses;
  - f. The ANO's exclude all rights, remedies, conditions and warranties, whether express or implied, in relation to the Online Systems and Services and any goods or services accessible or promoted via the Online Systems arising under custom, law or statute which may be excluded; NA will not be liable for any direct loss or damage that you may suffer as a result of using the Online Systems or Services, or any loss of profit, sales, business opportunity, goodwill, anticipated savings or data, or for any special, indirect, incidental or consequential loss or damages of whatsoever kind resulting from the use of the Online Systems or Services, even if the ANO was aware or ought to have been aware of the possibility of such loss or damage, however, arising, whether in contract, tort, negligence, misrepresentation or otherwise;
  - g. Each ANO's liability in respect of any goods or services purchased from the Online Systems is limited to the lesser of:

- i. In the case of a supply of goods, the relevant ANO doing any one or more of the following (at NA's election): replacing the goods or supplying equivalent goods; repairing the goods; paying the cost of replacing the goods or of acquiring equivalent goods; or, paying the cost of having the goods repaired; and
    - ii. In the case of a supply of services, the relevant ANO doing either or both of the following (at NA's election): supplying the services again; or, paying the cost of having the services supplied again; and
  - h. Each ANO's aggregate liability to you under these Conditions of Use or in respect of all Online Systems and Services is limited to \$1,000 (if any).
- 10.2 You indemnify each ANO and their respective officers, employees, representatives, licensees and/or assignees against any claims, loss, damage or costs (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis) arising from or in connection with the posting or deletion of the Content submitted, uploaded, posted or transmitted by you, on your behalf or under your account, or any breach or alleged breach by you of these Conditions of Use or of any other legal rights or obligations or of any applicable laws.
- 10.3 You acknowledge that you are responsible for obtaining all necessary hardware, software and connections to use the Online Systems and Services and must pay all telecommunications costs and charges incurred by you in using the Online Systems and Services. The Online Systems or Services will not work on every device, operating system, or browser. Features may change, stop working, or be withdrawn if your device or software is not compatible, supported or updated.
- 10.4 Should an ANO be required to postpone events, competitions or other activities due to a pandemic, epidemic or other government directed restrictions, users acknowledge that any goods or services purchased using the Online Systems, on or after the government announced restrictions or Netball Australia's announcement (whichever came first), are non-refundable to the extent permitted by law.
- 10.5 Each ANO is severally responsible and liable for adhering to these Conditions of Use and their respective acts or omissions.
- 10.6 This section J entitled Disclaimer, Limitation of Liability and Indemnity survives the termination or expiry of these Conditions of Use or your discontinued use of the Online Systems or Services.

## 11. Modification of Content, Online Systems and Services

- 11.1 NA may update any content or feature on any Online System or Service from time to time, without notice.
- 11.2 The Online Systems and Services are provided on an "as is" basis and access to the Online Systems and Services depends on telecommunications and internet services providers and other external factors and the ANOs do not guarantee the availability of the Online Systems and Services at all or at any specific time. An ANO will not be in breach of these Conditions of Use or otherwise liable to you or any other person for any unavailability or failure of the Online Systems or the Services or any delay or other failure by an ANO to comply with these Conditions of Use that is caused by or arises from any event or circumstances beyond the control of an ANO, including natural disasters; extreme climatic or weather events; acts of war; terrorism; civil or political unrest; industrial action or strikes; third party non-performance; epidemics or pandemics; or government restrictions or sanctions; and failures of telecommunications, technology or utilities; Attacks by third parties.

- 11.3 The ANOs reserve the right at any time and from time to time to suspend access to, modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, the Online Systems and/or Services with or without notice.
- 11.4 You agree that an ANO will not be liable to you or to any third party for any modification, suspension, or discontinuance of the Online Systems and/or Services.

## **12. Suspension and Termination**

- 12.1 These Conditions of Use are effective until terminated by the relevant ANO. ANOs may (with or without notice to you) modify, restrict, prevent, withdraw, suspend or terminate your access to or use of the Online Systems and Services (including by blocking your access to the Online Systems and Services or deactivating your sign-on credentials) for any reason whatsoever or for no reason, and without prior notice to you, including where an ANO believes that you are in breach of these Conditions of Use.
- 12.2 You may discontinue using an Online System or Service at any time. If you do then: the unused portion of any subscriptions that are pre-paid by you will not be refunded; your ability to transact with an ANO or participate in netball might be restricted.
- 12.3 If you are no longer authorised or discontinue to access the Online Systems and Services, then all restrictions imposed on you, licences granted by you, moral right consents provided by you and all of NA's intellectual property rights, disclaimers and limitations of liability contained in these Conditions of Use will survive termination.

## **13. General**

- 13.1 These Conditions of Use may be updated by the ANOs from time to time. Each ANO will post, or link to, any amended Conditions of Use on all of the Online Systems. Your continued use of the Online Systems constitutes acceptance of the amended Conditions of Use.
- 13.2 Each ANO may assign its rights in whole or in part to any person in its absolute discretion. Each ANO may use sub-contractors in the performance or delivery of the Online Systems and Services.
- 13.3 These Conditions of Use are governed by the laws of the State of Victoria, Australia and you submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Victorian courts.
- 13.4 Any provision of these Conditions of Use that is either wholly or partly unenforceable will be severed to the extent necessary to make the remaining provisions of these Conditions of Use enforceable.
- 13.5 Any partial exercise, failure to exercise, or delay in exercising a power, right or remedy provided under these Conditions of Use, or by law, does not operate as a waiver, or prevent or restrict any further or later exercise of that power, right, or remedy.
- 13.6 Any dispute or proceeding that you wish to resolve or litigate in any forum will be conducted by you solely on an individual basis. You will not seek to have any dispute or proceeding heard as a class action or in any other proceeding in which a party acts or proposes to act in a representative capacity. You will not combine any proceeding with another without our prior written consent
- 13.7 An ANO is not responsible for delay or failure to perform obligations under these Conditions of Use (other than the payment of money) to the extent they are affected by a Force Majeure

Event. Obligations are suspended while the Force Majeure Event continues. The affected ANO must notify you as soon as reasonably practicable. If a Force Majeure Event continues for more than 90 days, either the ANO or you may terminate your access to and use of the affected Online System or Service by written notice. Termination does not affect rights or obligations that arose before the Force Majeure Event. “Force Majeure Event” means an event beyond a party’s reasonable control that prevents or delays full compliance with these Conditions of Use. Examples include natural disasters; extreme climatic or weather events; acts of war; terrorism; civil or political unrest; industrial action or strikes; third party non-performance; epidemics or pandemics; or government restrictions or sanctions; and failures of telecommunications, technology or utilities; Attacks by third parties.

13.8 In these Conditions of Use, unless the context requires otherwise:

- a. a reference to a “participant” means anyone involved in a game of netball, both on and off the court and whether paid or volunteer, including players, coaches, umpires, trainers, managers, administrators, officials, and support personnel; “participate” and “participation” have similar meanings.
- b. any reference to a “person” includes any individual, company, corporation, firm partnership, joint venture, association, organisation or trust (in each case, whether or not having separate legal personality) and references to any of the same shall include a reference to the others;
- c. any phrase introduced by the words “including”, “include”, “in particular”, “for example” or any similar expression shall be construed as illustrative only and shall not be construed as limiting the generality of any preceding words;
- d. references to the singular include the plural and to the masculine include the feminine, and in each case vice versa; and
